18 Petitioner appears to be a member of the Bond Eligible Class certified in
19 *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---,
20 2025 WL 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The Ninth Circuit later stayed application
21 of the Order beyond the Central District of California. However, Respondents
22 acknowledges the prior orders from this District directing bond hearings pursuant to
23 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) in similar cases.¹

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27 ¹ To the extent the Court issues an order directing a bond hearing under § 1226(a),
28 considering heavy caseloads and staffing levels, Respondents respectfully request that
such order provide the government 14 days from issuance to hold such bond hearing.

1 Respondents therefore do not oppose an order from this Court directing a bond
2 hearing be held pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a).²
