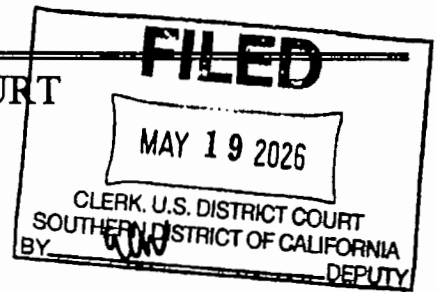

Please Release me so that I can be with my family, who is over 2000 miles away from me. So that I can take care of my father and my mom.

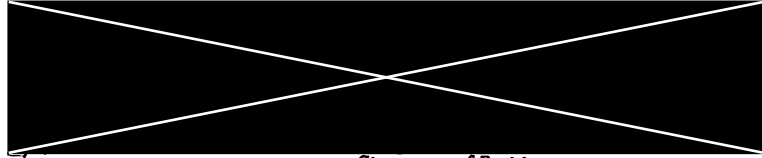
