DECLARATION OF
MARIO L. TREVINO
DEPORTATION OFFICER

I, MARIO L. TREVINO, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a Deportation Officer (“DO”) employed by the United States Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”), Office of Enforcement and Removal Operations (“ERO”). I am and have been employed with ICE since 2023.
2. I have been tasked with reviewing and responding to a request for records regarding PETITIONER Kevin Jose R.-M. (“Petitioner”).
3. I make this declaration based on my personal and professional knowledge, my review of records and systems maintained by ICE in the regular course of business, and information provided by other agents and officers.
4. Petitioner is a native and citizen of Honduras. Petitioner entered the United States unlawfully without inspection on or about May 2, 2019.
5. On May 5, 2019, DHS initiated removal proceedings by issuing Petitioner a Notice to Appear, Form I-862, charging him under INA § 212(a)(6).
6. On October 26, 2023, an immigration judge administratively closed Petitioner’s removal proceedings.

7. On November 13, 2025, the Meeker County, Minnesota, District Court convicted
1 Petitioner of “Cannabis Open Package – Owner/Driver of Motor Vehicle”
2 (169A.36.4(3)), case number 47-CR-25-705, and sentenced Petitioner to 30 days
3 confinement.
8. On April 5, 2026, the Montevideo, Minnesota, Police Department arrested Petitioner for
4 Driving While Impaired – Fourth Degree (169A.20.1(8), Carry/Posses Pistol without a
5 Permit (624.714.1a), and Carry a Pistol While Under the Influence (624.7142.1(7)), case
6 number 12-CR-26-193. These charges are pending disposition.
9. On April 5, 2026, ICE/ERO identified a booking record for Petitioner at the Chippewa
8 County Jail in Montevideo, Minnesota. ICE/ERO lodged a detainer to the Chippewa
9 County Jail for Petitioner that same day.
10. On April 7, 2026, ICE/ERO Deportation Officer M. Trevino served Petitioner with an I-
11 200, Warrant for Arrest of Alien, at the Chippewa County Jail, placed Petitioner under
12 arrest, and transported Petitioner to the Kandiyohi County Jail, Minnesota, for further
13 processing.
- 14 11. On May 6, 2026, an immigration judge granted a DHS motion to re-calendar Petitioner’s
15 removal proceedings and place it on the court’s active docket.
- 16 12. On May 18, 2026, an immigration judge found Petitioner inadmissible as charged in the
17 Notice to Appear and ordered Petitioner removed to Honduras. Petitioner waived his
18 right to appeal the immigration judge’s order to the Board of Immigration Appeals.
- 19 13. On May 27, 2026, an ICE/ERO Acting Field Office Director issued an I-205, Warrant of
20 Removal/Deportation, finding that Petitioner is removable from the United States based
21 on a final order by an immigration judge.
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14. On June 14, 2026, Petitioner appealed the immigration judge's removal order to the
1 Board of Immigration Appeals. That appeal is pending.

2 15. On June 26, 2026, ICE/ERO transferred Petitioner from the Kandiyohi County Jail to the
3 Freeborn County Jail, Minnesota, where Petitioner remains detained.

4 16. Attached is a true and correct copy of Forms I-247A, I-200, I-862, I-213, I-205 and the
5 immigration judge's removal order.

6 17. The Forms I-247A, I-200, I-862, I-213, and I-205 were kept in the course of regularly
7 conducted activity of DHS/ICE.

8 18. The Forms I-247A, I-200, I-862, I-213, and I-205 were made by an employee of
9 DHS/ICE who obtained information from immigration officers, Petitioner, and law
10 enforcement information sources regularly maintained in the ordinary course of business
11 by DHS/ICE.

12 19. Making the Forms I-247A, I-200, I-862, I-213, and I-205 is a regular practice of
13 DHS/ICE.

15 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing
16 is true and correct.
